WHERE CAN I GET NALOXONE?

For easy access to Naloxone, Ohio allows authorized pharmacists and Project DAWN (<u>Deaths Avoided</u> with Naloxone) locations to dispense naloxone over the counter without a prescription. Project DAWN locations provide naloxone at no cost. Click on the links below for more information or call:

WHAT INFORMATION IS REQUIRED TO GET NALOXONE?

Although naloxone has been approved in Ohio to be dispensed over the counter there are still safety measures the pharmacists must follow when you arrive. These include a short training session, less than 15 minutes, on the use of naloxone. The pharmacist will then document training occurred or was offered, the quantity of medication dispensed and the name of person receiving the medication.¹

You have the choice to use your medication prescription coverage insurance or pay out of pocket. If you receive services at a Project DAWN location, the training and naloxone are provided free of charge.
